The *1-Minute-Europe Film Competition* is an initiative of the EU Center of Wenzao Ursuline University. It aims to encourage students to share their experiences about Europe and engage in discussion about the meaning of Europe.

Participation is limited to students from *Wenzao Ursuline University of Languages*.

The main theme for the 2020 competition is ***'My Europe'***.

Europe has plenty to offer, it is a diverse and culturally rich continent. Despite the geographic distance, Europe and Taiwan share common values. Show us your impressions of Europe! Did you travel there? Did you make friends there? Are you learning a European language? What means Europe to your life? Are you interested in European culture or movies? Or European history? What do you think about the European Union? Or you want to share something about European music, literature, art...

Entrants may create a piece of fiction, a short documentary, a community-service, an animated short clip, a music clip (copyright!) or ... All genres are accepted, animated or live-action, funny or serious.

Be creative!

It is advised to focus on a particular aspect of the topic to tell your story about Europe.

Awards and Prizes:

- 1) A jury of experts awards the best short film.
1st price: 1,500 TWD + Goodie Pack
2nd price: 1,000 TWD + Goodie Pack

- 2) Audience Choice Award (voted online)
1st price: 1,000 TWD + Goodie Pack

Certificates are awarded for all price winners!

Entrants must adhere to the following guidelines:

- 1) Films completed after: March 5th 2020
- 2) Maximum duration: 1 Minute
- 3) Format: MP4 or MOV format
(HD and be sure the film can be uploaded to FB)
- 4) Accepted genres: all
- 5) Language: English or Chinese (English subtitles for all other languages)

Submission deadline: **April 20th, 2020**

Notification of results: **May 7th, 2020**

Further explanation:

Each film must be no longer than 60 seconds. Closing credits are not required, if added, a maximum of 10 seconds in total extra at the end.

At the end of the film, an "EU Center" logo must be placed 3-second.

The video file size should be less than 1GB.

Films may be in English or Chinese or without dialogues at all. Non-English or Non-Chinese clips must have English subtitles.

Please ensure that all content in your film is your own and respect copyrights. Entries with unauthorized content are disqualified.
